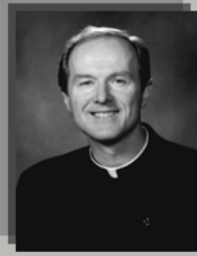

Dear Parishioners :

1. BUILDING PROJECT:

As I announced this last Sunday, we received really wonderful bids from the contractors who we asked to bid on the project. Dondlinger & Sons, Law Company, and Simpson Construction. Simpson Construction provided us the lowest bid and was awarded the project. We are in the process of working with Bishop Kemme's office to secure contracts with this company.

It was my hope that we could have worked

with all three companies in building the new Church, school, and cafeteria. Unfortunately, that would have been confusing, and each company directed us to allow them to bid on the project separately. I would have been honored and happy to work with any of these three companies. Each company is dependable and honorable and would have built a beautiful complex.

In addition, each of these three companies guided our thoughts regarding the construction of the new facilities at no cost. Normally, this process is rather costly, but each company willingly came to the table and offered invaluable insights. I hope you will join me in thanking Tom Dondlinger, Rich Kerschen (Law Company), and Bob Simpson for their dedication to Holy Savior Parish.

2. CATHOLIC FAMILY FEDERAL CREDIT UNION:

STEWARDSHIP "WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?"
